



Call for Papers: 2023 Jackson Hole Wildlife Symposium

Submission Deadline: September 30, 2023

The Northern Rockies Conservation Cooperative (NRCC) will host the 9th biennial Jackson Hole Wildlife Symposium (JHWS) at the Center for the Arts in Jackson, WY on Thursday, October 26, 2023. The afternoon will consist of two “Quick Talk” sessions. Presentations are 6 minutes in length and should appeal to a broad audience, by focusing on key lessons and takeaways. The presentations should seek to provide an overview of the project and its significance to the broad and changing dynamics at-play in the GYE. An open Q&A forum with all presenters will be held at the end of the session.

We invite submissions of research papers or project abstracts on topics of:

- **Human-wildlife coexistence**
- **Innovative conservation**
- **Social and ecological issues**
- **Common interest policy and management**
- **Governance responses**

We welcome work in the areas of **science, management, conservation, education, or policy** that is situated in Jackson Hole or the GYE. Presenters from universities, agencies, non-profits, and independent researchers are all welcome. The goal is to communicate current research and conservation projects to the general public and natural resource leaders. We encourage submissions to emphasize *how and why* this work is important to furthering human-wildlife coexistence.
